You will focus on managing and optimizing our Azure cloud environments and on-prem systems, enforcing SOC 2 compliance, and driving automation to reduce operational risk. This position is also responsible for laying the foundation for multi-tenant standards to support future expansion to DLC, while incorporating AI-driven tools for smarter operations and predictive insights.

You will work closely with IT, Product, and Operations teams to maintain and enhance systems that are crucial to the business, ensuring secure, stable, and efficient operations across our platforms.

If you’re passionate about building secure, scalable, and intelligent infrastructure in a fast-moving fintech environment, this is the role for you!

WHAT YOU WILL DO

- **Cloud & Infrastructure Management:** Operate and optimize Azure environments, including compute, storage, networking, and databases. Build and maintain Infrastructure as Code (Terraform/Bicep) and integrate with CI/CD pipelines to ensure consistent, auditable deployments.



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- **Server & Endpoint Administration:** Maintain Linux and Windows servers, virtualization platforms, and endpoint security using MDM/EDR solutions. Ensure systems are patched and hardened according to compliance requirements.
- **Identity & Access Control:** Administer identity platforms (Entra ID/Okta) and manage privileged access workflows (PIM/PAM). Enforce least privilege principles and participate in quarterly access reviews.
- **Monitoring & Incident Response:** Implement observability tools for logging, metrics, and alerting. Maintain runbooks and participate in a 24x7 on call rotation, ensuring rapid incident response and adherence to defined MTTR targets.
- **Backup & Disaster Recovery:** Own backup strategies across all critical assets, define RPO/RTO objectives, and conduct quarterly restore tests to validate disaster recovery readiness.
- **Compliance & Change Management:** Uphold SOC 2 controls by maintaining evidence for audits, managing change windows, and ensuring accurate CMDB records.
- **AI-Driven Operations:** Leverage AI-based monitoring and anomaly detection tools to predict infrastructure issues before they occur. Use machine learning models for capacity planning, performance optimization, and automated remediation workflows.
- **Cross-Organizational Readiness:** Design infrastructure standards that support multi-tenant environments, including IAM boundaries, per tenant logging, and cost allocation tagging for DLC scalability.

- 5+ years of experience in system administration, infrastructure, or cloud operations
- Proven experience managing Azure environments and automation through IaC (Terraform/Bicep).
- Strong scripting skills (PowerShell, Bash, Python) for operational automation.
- Expertise in identity management, endpoint security, and compliance frameworks (SOC 2 preferred).
- Familiarity with observability stacks and incident management practices.
- Hands-on experience with backup/restore tooling and disaster recovery planning.
- Exposure to AI/ML tools for IT operations (e.g., predictive analytics, anomaly detection, automated remediation).
- Strong analytical, troubleshooting, and problem-solving skills.
- Excellent communication and collaboration skills.
